

Want to know more about how we're being the change we want to see in the world? Here are some interesting facts on how we championed sustainability within our flagship Pune campus in 2021-22:

A Solar Power Plant:

daytime energy requirements.

Biodegradable Waste:

A 100kg capacity composting plant

and generates compost, which is

used to keep our gardens green.

Our 200 cu.m capacity Sewage

Treatment Plant treats and recycles

Reusing Water:

processes biodegradable waste daily

KPIT Pune campus' car parking lot of

8,000+ sq. m was covered with solar

panels turning it into a solar power

plant. It fulfils 75% of the campus'



sewage water, 80% of which is used for flushing and gardening purposes. Additionally, drip irrigation in internal gardens, pressure and leakage checks, and rainwater harvesting help conserve water too.
